

# **Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990**

## **Report of Motions Pending More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted More Than Six Months, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months, Social Security Appeal Cases Pending More Than Six Months, and Civil Cases Pending More Than Three Years on September 30, 2009**

### **Introduction**

The Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990 (CJRA) requires the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts (AO), under 28 U.S.C. § 476, to prepare a semiannual report showing, by U.S. district judge and magistrate judge, all motions pending more than six months, all bench trials that have remained undecided more than six months, and all civil cases pending more than three years. The reporting requirements under the CJRA are designed to help reduce both costs and delays in civil litigation in the district courts. The information also may be used to evaluate demands on the district courts' resources.

This is the 37<sup>th</sup> semiannual report prepared pursuant to the CJRA that shows all motions in civil cases pending more than six months, civil bench trials submitted more than six months, and civil cases pending more than three years. In accordance with the Judicial Conference mandates of 1998, this report also presents data on bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months and Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months.

The CJRA report is prepared primarily by automated means through the use of the Case Management/Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) System. As a result, pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases are being reported in a standardized and consistent fashion, and all judges using these systems have the most accurate tools to help them prepare semiannual reports.

For the CJRA report for September 30, 2009, all 94 U.S. district courts used the AO's national CM/ECF System or a simulation of this system to report all pending civil matters.

Appendix A provides data for each U.S. district judge and U.S. magistrate judge on motions pending, bench trials submitted, cases pending, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeal cases pending. The CJRA requires the AO Director to establish uniform standards for determining when a motion, bench trial, case, or bankruptcy appeal is "pending"; Appendix B lists these definitions.

Along with the semiannual consolidated national report, the AO prepares a supplemental report, *A Report on Motions Pending for More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted for More Than Six Months, Civil Cases Pending Three Years or More, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending for More Than Six Months, and Social Security Appeal Cases Pending for More Than Six Months on September 30, 2009*, which provides detailed information regarding the individual cases, motions, bench trials, and appeals pending in the U.S. district courts. This document is available to the public through the U.S. district courts, the executive offices of the U.S. courts of appeals, the AO, and the Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) system.

## Report Findings

The information in this report presents what may best be described as a “snapshot” of motions pending more than six months, bench trials submitted more than six months, civil cases pending more than three years, and bankruptcy appeals and Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months on September 30, 2009. District judge and magistrate judge caseloads change constantly, so many of the matters pending on September 30, 2009, have since been decided or transferred to other judges. Those using reports of this type thus should take into account the state of change in the district courts’ pending caseloads.

Although the information provided in this report pertains to the pending civil caseload of district judges and magistrate judges, readers should take into consideration the overall case processing demands placed on the courts by both civil and criminal matters. An accurate assessment of the demands placed on the district courts also requires consideration of numerous factors, including vacant judgeships and the effects of all cases making up each court’s caseload.

## Methodology

This national report is designed to place special emphasis on detailed analyses that are extracted from the national CM/ECF system or obtained by other automated means. Each U.S. district court is required to analyze the reasons for delays in disposing of pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases. Judges use status codes to provide reasons for delays in these matters (see Appendix C). More specific information about motions pending, bench trials submitted, and cases pending on March 31, 2009, and September 30, 2009, appears in Tables 1, 2, 3, and 4.

## Numbers of Motions Pending, Bench Trials Submitted, Cases Pending, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending, and Social Security Appeal Cases Pending on September 30, 2009.

**Motions.** The total number of motions pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges fell 1 percent (down 60 motions) from 5,848 on March 31, 2009, to 5,788 on September 30, 2009. Ninety-two percent of all motions pending were before district judges, and 8 percent were before magistrate judges.

For the September 30, 2009, CJRA report, seven circuits reported decreases in pending motions, and 5 circuits reported increases. The most substantial reductions in pending motions occurred in the Eleventh Circuit (down 133 motions), Second Circuit (down 89 motions), and Third Circuit (down 69 motions). In the Eleventh Circuit, seven of the nine district courts saw reductions in motions in multiple types of civil cases. In the Second Circuit, five of the six district courts reported decreases in pending motions. In the Third Circuit, the Eastern District of Pennsylvania reduced its pending motions by 78 as a single district judge disposed of 87 motions in various types of civil cases.

*Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Motions.* District courts provided status codes for each of the 5,788 motions reported on September 30, 2009 (see Appendix C). The majority of these codes (66 percent) were in the following 10 categories: opinion/decision in draft (1,225 motions), referred to magistrate judge (479 motions), heavy criminal and civil caseload (389 motions), complexity of case (326 motions), decided after the end of the reporting period (278 motions), voluminous brief/transcripts to be read (268 motions), settlement pending (248 motions), recently received from magistrate judge on recommen-

dation (208 motions), awaiting materials (204 motions), and hearing on motion necessary (199 motions).

*Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Motions.* The majority of the nature of suit codes provided by district courts for pending motions (see Appendix D) for September 30, 2009, were for the following eight types of civil cases: civil rights (1,403 motions), prisoner petitions (1,131 motions), contract (835 motions), personal injury (673 motions), intellectual property rights (413 motions), labor (395 motions), securities/commodities/exchange (147 motions), and racketeer influenced and corrupt organizations (145 motions).

**Bench Trials.** The total number of bench trials pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges declined from 90 on March 31, 2009, to 78 on September 30, 2009. Pending bench trials in various types of civil cases declined in 4 of the 12 circuits, rose in 4 circuits, and remained unchanged in 4 circuits.

*Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bench Trials.* District courts provided status codes for each of the 78 pending bench trials to indicate reasons for delays. The following four status codes covered 54 percent of the reasons for delays: opinion/decision in draft (29 trials), heavy criminal and civil caseload (5 trials), voluminous brief/transcripts to be read (5 trials), and complexity of case (4 trials).

*Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Bench Trials.* The nature of suit codes used most often for pending bench trials were contract (19 trials), civil rights (14 trials), personal injury (13 trials), intellectual property rights (9 trials), prisoner petitions (5 trials), and labor cases (5 trials).

**Three-Year-Old Cases.** The number of civil cases pending more than three years increased 13 percent from 18,800 on March 31, 2009, to 21,290 (up 2,490 cases) on September 30, 2009. District judges reported 98 percent of all pending three-year-old cases, and magistrate judges reported the remaining 2 percent. Three-year-old cases increased in 6 of the 12 circuits. The most significant jumps occurred in the Fifth Circuit (up 1,756 cases),

Second Circuit (up 757 cases), Eighth Circuit (up 474 cases), and Seventh Circuit (up 103 cases). In the Fifth Circuit, the three-year-old caseload in the Eastern District of Louisiana rose by 1,744 cases; as in the previous reporting period, this rise consisted mostly of personal injury/product liability suits alleging injuries from the drug Vioxx. In the Second Circuit, three-year-old cases in the Southern District of New York increased by 671 cases, most of them related to the terrorist-related aircraft crashes on September 11, 2001, or to multidistrict litigation filings of various types in the district. In the Eighth Circuit, a personal injury multidistrict litigation case related to hormone replacement therapy caused the pending caseload in the Eastern District of Arkansas to increase by 588 cases. In the Seventh Circuit, the Northern District of Illinois reported 100 new three-year-old cases of various types.

*Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Three-Year-Old Cases.* District courts provided status codes for all 21,290 three-year-old cases to indicate the reasons for delays. The vast majority of status codes used (84 percent) fell into the following 9 categories: multidistrict litigation (11,265 cases), complexity of case (2,609 cases), referred to magistrate judge (1,002 cases), trial scheduled (686 cases), settlement pending (604 cases), opinion/decision in draft (479 cases), awaiting materials (476 cases), set for status conference (346 cases), and extensive discovery involved (304 cases).

*Primary Nature of Suit Codes In Pending Three-Year-Old Cases.* The following 10 nature of suit codes were used most often for pending three-year-old cases: personal injury (12,932 cases), prisoner petitions (2,303 petitions), civil rights (1,464 cases), securities/commodities/exchange (965 cases), contract (890 cases), antitrust (551 cases), labor (425 cases), intellectual property rights (383 cases), environmental matters (146 cases), and racketeer influenced and corrupt organizations (102 cases).

**Bankruptcy Appeals.** Bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months dropped 28 percent from 190 on March 31, 2009, to 137 on September 30, 2009. All

pending bankruptcy appeals were reported by district judges. Declines occurred in 10 of the 12 circuits, and the totals remained unchanged in 2 circuits. Four circuits reported 80 percent of all pending bankruptcy appeals (110 appeals): the Second Circuit (53 appeals), Ninth Circuit (33 appeals), Third Circuit (12 appeals), and Seventh Circuit (12 appeals). As in previous reporting periods, court officials cited better case management practices as the major reason for the continued decline of pending bankruptcy appeals.

*Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bankruptcy Appeals.* District courts provided status codes for each of the 137 pending bankruptcy appeals to indicate the reasons for delays. Sixty-four percent of these codes fell into the following seven categories: opinion/decision in draft (25 appeals), awaiting materials (17 appeals), case consolidated (15 appeals), heavy criminal and civil caseload (13 appeals), voluminous brief/transcripts to be read (9 appeals), hearing on motion necessary (5 appeals), and decided after the end of the reporting period (4 appeals).

**Social Security Appeal Cases.** Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months dropped 22 percent (down 153 cases) from 682 on March 31, 2009, to 529 on September 30, 2009. District judges reported 74 percent of these cases, and magistrate judges reported 26 percent. Nine of the 12 circuits had reductions, 2 had increases, and 1 had no change. The nine circuits with smaller pending caseloads reported a combined decrease of 168 cases. The Second Circuit (down 65 cases) contributed to 43 percent of the national decline in pending Social Security appeal cases as the Northern District of New York disposed of 47 such cases. This court terminated previously pending Social Security cases by using visiting judges, redistributing the cases among judicial officers for resolution, and recalling a magistrate judge specifically to work on the backlog of these cases.

*Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Social Security Appeal Cases.* District courts provided status codes for all 529 pending Social Security appeal cases. Seventy-seven percent of these codes fell into the following nine categories: referred to magistrate judge (106 cases), opinion/decision in draft (90 cases), voluminous brief/transcripts to be read (54

cases), awaiting materials (41 cases), heavy criminal and civil caseload (32 cases), recently received from magistrate judge on recommendation (29 cases), parties given additional time to file supplemental briefs (24 cases), recently received from the calendar of another judge (16 cases), and decided after the end of the reporting period (15 cases).

*Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Social Security Appeal Cases.* Ninety-three percent of the nature of suit codes provided for pending Social Security appeal cases (492 cases) were related to disability insurance or supplemental security income.

Detailed guidelines for making reports under the CJRA on pending motions, bench trials, and cases appear in the AO's *Guide to Judiciary Policy*; see Volume 18 (Statistics, Chapter 5 of Appendix 5C). Several issues relevant to the reporting of cases pending for more than three years include the following.

- With respect to cases pending for more than three years that have been assigned to district judges and magistrate judges from outside the districts where the cases originated, such cases are included in the totals for the districts where they were filed initially. Sometimes a block of cases or a class of cases that are similar in nature is assigned to a single judge. Such cases often require lengthy litigation when they involve complex issues and large numbers of parties.
- This report includes some asbestos cases. The Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation (MDL) authorized the transfer of most of the pending asbestos personal injury/product liability cases to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania under Order Number 875. Asbestos cases that have remained in the districts where they were filed originally or that were transferred back to the original districts are included in this report. However, those cases transferred according to MDL Docket 875 are excluded. All other MDL cases are included in this report.

**Cases Pending More Than Three Years.** The CJRA requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of cases pending more than three years in the district courts. A case becomes pending as of the date the case originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was reopened, whichever is later. If a case has not been disposed of within three years after its filing date or reopening date, the case shall be reported as pending more than three years.

**Motions Pending More Than Six Months.** The CJRA mandates a report enumerating all motions that have been pending six months or longer. A motion is a request made to a district judge or magistrate judge for an order, ruling, or similar determination. The opposing party has 30 days from the date of a motion's filing to respond to it. A motion becomes pending 30 days after the date it was filed or was referred to a magistrate judge, whichever is later. If no decision on a motion has been filed within six months after the date the motion became pending, and the motion has not been referred to a magistrate judge, the motion shall be reported as pending more than six months before the presiding judge. If a motion is referred to a magistrate judge, the magistrate judge must file a report and make a recommendation for, or dispose of, the motion within six months after the date the motion became pending, or the motion shall be reported as pending for both the district judge and the magistrate judge.

**Bench Trials Submitted More than Six Months.** The CJRA requires the AO to prepare a report of bench trials submitted more than six months. In a bench trial, the judge (rather than a jury) decides the facts of the case. A bench trial is considered to be submitted on the date the courtroom proceedings are concluded. If a judge fails to file an opinion within six months after a bench trial was submitted, the bench trial shall be reported as submitted more than six months.

**Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months.** In accordance with an action of the March 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months in the district courts. A bankruptcy appeal becomes pending as of the date the appeal originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was re-

opened, whichever is later. If an appeal has not been disposed of within six months plus 60 days after its filing date or reopening date, the appeal shall be reported as pending more than six months.

**Social Security Appeal Cases Pending More Than Six Months.** In accordance with an action of the September 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months in the district courts. A Social Security appeal case becomes pending as of the date of the filing of the latest transcript in such case. If a case has not been disposed of within six months plus 120 days after its filing date, the case shall be reported as pending more than six months.
