The supplemental report to the Federal Bureau of Prisons helps the Bureau in classification and designation procedures.

⁶ Modified Guideline - Reports that are prepared if the court determines that it has most of the information it would need to impose a sentence, and additional information is not needed to make a Bureau or Prisons designation or programming decision or for post-conviction supervision. The report is the result of a less comprehensive investigation than a full presentence report.
