After reviewing the proposed amendments to the Rules of Civil Procedure it is my humble opinion that a thirty-day period of time rather than a ten-day period of time provided for filing in Rules 50, 52 and 59 (b), (d), (e) is a change that is unnecessary and can lead to an unnecessary delay in past judgment matters Rule 6 provides that Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays are not counted in the ten-day period I should think that a party wishing to avail himself or herself of Rules 50, 52 and 59 should be in a position to be able to make that decision within ten days I appreciate the opportunity to add my two cents
