Dear Sirs:

I write to endorse, strongly, the proposed changes regarding proof of claim in bankruptcy. The risk that a creditor has erroneously failed to credit all payments, or has transferred the claim to one or more debt buyers who have failed to maintain clear accounting, should fall on the creditor who files the proof of claim, who is in the best position to perform such accounting and ensure its accuracy. Current rules may allow such risk (and expense) to be shifted to the debtor, who has neither the financial nor time resources, nor expertise, to do it.
