## (2) Producing Documents, <u>Electronically Stored Information</u>, and <u>Tangible</u> <u>Things</u>. If a subpoena duces tecum is to be served on the deponent, the materials designated for production, as set out in the subpoena, must be listed in the notice or in an attachment. The notice to a party deponent may be accompanied by a request under Rule 34 to produce documents, <u>electronically stored information</u>, and tangible things at the deposition.

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
